Question:

Where can I find in Sister White writings that has to do with motherless children in Heaven?

Answer:

This site is a Bible-focused site, so volunteers like myself are Bible experts and less Ellen White experts. But I do have resources to help me answer your question.

I can tell you that the Bible really doesn't have anything to say on the issue. It does speak frequently of the "fatherless," but those passages all regard the obligation of individuals to care for them. Ellen White has much to say about orphans and about the obligations of the church, individuals, and childless couples toward them.

The reference I think you're looking for was penned by Ellen White on the death of her twin sister's infant in 1858. Her words were reproduced in the Youth's Instructor and can be found today in Selected Messages book two, page 260. I'd encourage you to read the whole passage. Here's the key portion:

As the little infants come forth immortal from their dusty beds, they immediately wing their way to their mother's arms. They meet again nevermore to part. But many of the little ones have no mother there. We listen in vain for the rapturous song of triumph from the mother. The angels receive the motherless infants and conduct them to the tree of life.

That sounds like exactly what you were looking for.
